He has been involved in the hands-on rehab of over 150 endangered, historic properties over his career.

The school is located in the historic Lamb-Munger House at 521 Bird Street in Hannibal, Missouri. Hannibal is a very historic Mississippi River town and the childhood home of Samuel Clemens aka Mark Twain.
